Mr. Bieker motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Mr. Graham - Motion carried unanimously.

5. **DISCLOSURE OF POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST.** Membership did not disclose any potential conflicts of interest.

6. PUBLIC COMMENTS.

7. <u>APPROVAL OF PAST MINUTES.</u>

Mr. Graham moved to approve the meeting minutes from January 27, 2022, seconded by Mr. Bieker. – Motion carried unanimously.

8. FINANCIAL REPORTS.

Mr. Zick moved to approve the January 2022 financial statement, seconded by Mr. Graham. – Motion carried unanimously.

9. **DECISION ITEM**: Executive Committee Nomination.

Mr. Thomas opened the discussion by summarizing a Weld County Work Session on February 7, 2022. The Weld County Commissioners requested that Mr. Tom Parko, Weld County Director of Planning Services, serve on the Association Executive Committee. Therefore, Mr. Graham nominated Mr. Tom Parko to serve on the Association Executive Committee, followed by Mr. Parko accepting the nomination. Mr. Fleck moved to approve the nomination of Mr. Parko to fulfill the vacant Executive committee seat, seconded by Mr. Zick. – Motion carried unanimously.

10. <u>DECISION ITEM</u>: Pine Lake Village Mobile Home Park – Derating to OWTS.

Mr. Don Goulart, the owner of the Pine Lake Village Mobile Home Park, presented the background regarding the derating of the system. The main driver for the system's derating is that the current permitted OWTS system cannot meet water quality limits for nitrates and sulfates due to surrounding groundwater influences. The current treatment facility consists of a 16,000-gallon three-chamber septic tank and four 100' X 105' leach fields. The existing OWTS design and permitted capacity is 7,090 gpd. The observed average daily wastewater flow is 2,369 gpd. It is proposed to split the collection system reducing the flow to less than 2,000 gpd creating two systems rated at 2,000 gpd and 1,000 gpd, and derate the entire system from the state. The Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment has approved the site application. Mr. Brand moved to approve the derating of the Pine Lake Village Mobile Home Park, seconded by Mr. Hepworth. – Motion carried unanimously.

11. **DECISION ITEM**: Boxelder Sanitation District Drake Interceptor Site Application.

Mr. Thomas introduced the Boxelder Sanitation District Site Application for the extension of the Drake sewer interceptor, explaining the Site Application meets the requirements for approval by the Association Manager with membership notification. Mr. Zick gave a presentation regarding the Drake Sewer interceptor extension Site Application. Boxelder Sanitation District completed Utility Plan updates in 2014 and 2018, which documents the Drake Sewer interceptor planned extension for the service area basin. Mr. Thomas explained although the agenda topic was a Decision Item, this was a Discussion Item for membership notification only. Voting was not required.

12. <u>DECISION ITEM</u>: Town of Mead Utility Plan and 208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan Amendment.

Mr. John McGee with JVA presented the Town of Mead Utility Plan and 208 Areawide Water Quality

Management Plan Amendment concerning a wastewater utility service area boundary modification. The presentation can be viewed online here: <u>https://nfrwqpa.colorado.gov/meeting-presentations</u>. Mr. Thomas informed membership local agency approvals were obtained from Mead, Weld County, St. Vrain Sanitation District; however, support was not received from Berthoud at this time. Mr. Brand moved to approve the Mead Utility Plan and 208 Boundary modification, seconded by Mr. Bieker. – Motion carried unanimously.

13. <u>DISCUSSION ITEM</u>: 2022 - 208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan Data Call.

Mr. Thomas requested membership to provide the Association with their 2022 Agency Point Source Data Inventory sheets to ensure the correct data is being provided for the 2022-208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan. The Agency Point Source Data Inventory sheets provide general information about the agency, the most recent population and loading projections, and near-term wastewater collection and treatment construction needs. A listing within the Attachments of the agenda illustrated which membership agencies have provided updated information and who has not. The data is requested by March 31, 2022.

14. **DECISION ITEM**: Nonpoint Watershed Plan – Define the study area.

Mr. Thomas opened the discussion to define the study area of the Nonpoint Source Watershed plan. The proposal focused on the urban areas for each river basin, as illustrated by the attachment found within the agenda. The Nonpoint Watershed Plan can't evaluate the whole Larimer/Weld County region, or the message or purpose of the plan will get lost in 6,651+ acres and five water basins. The discussion provided by Mr. Dinges, Mr. Hartenstine, and Mr. Parko led membership to table a decision at this time in favor of creating a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC then would evaluate and prioritize the study areas and how the watersheds Nonpoint Source Watershed plans are written. Evaluation criteria may be based on the number of impaired stream segments or river basin needs. The developed TAC then would make recommendations to the membership throughout the Nonpoint Watershed Plan project.
